### Entry Rules

- 1 All entrants must be currently enrolled as a secondary student in a school within the State of Western Australia.
- 2 There is no entry fee, and no hidden fees during the competition.
- 3 Entries must not exceed 300 words. The word count should be written on the entry form and on the essay.
- 4 Only one entry per student is permitted.
- 5 Co-written entries will not be accepted.
- 6 Entries must be legible, ie. typed or neatly hand written.
- 7 Typed entries should be provided simply as black text on single-sided A4-sized sheets of paper. Times New Roman or Arial at 12-point size is highly recommended. Illustrations or pictures are not to be included.
- 8 An fully completed entry form with signature accepting the T&C's must accompany your essay.
- 9 Initial entries are considered your final entry. Revised versions will not be accepted.
- 10 The judges' decision is final. Correspondence will not be entered into.
- 11 Copying the work of others is called plagiarism. Plagiarised entries will be disqualified.

- 15 Entries will not be returned.
- 16 Winning entrants will be notified by mail or email and where possible by phone.
- 17 The list of winners will be published on the national DonateLife website and Facebook sites. Selected entries also may be published in DonateLife communications and local media.
- 18 By entering the competition, you agree to the above and give DonateLife the rights to use these materials on these sites, and in promotion of future competitions.
- 19 DonateLife WA reserves the right to cancel the competition or category if insufficient entries or quality has been received.
