

About the Stephanie Alexander Kitchen Garden Foundation (Who we are)

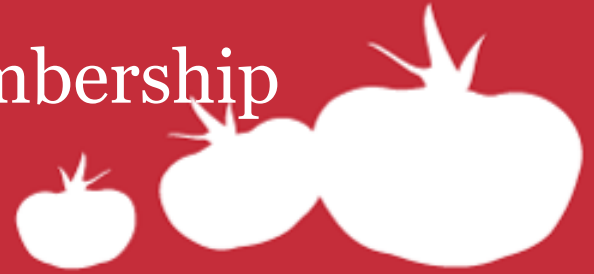


- Stephanie Alexander piloted the first Kitchen Garden Program at Collingwood College in 2001.
- The Foundation was established in 2004 to engage more schools and support them to deliver the program. In 2005 there were three Kitchen Garden Program Schools.
- In March 2015 the Foundation reached its goal of seeing the program delivered in 10% of Australian schools with a primary curriculum – over 800 schools.
- In order for pleasurable food education to reach more children and communities, the Foundation launched a new membership service – the Kitchen Garden Classroom.
