Please join us with an interactive stall at the **CJ Health Festival** on **Wednesday 15 May (term 2, week 3)**

Once again the aim of the CJ Health Festival is to create links that promote healthy lifestyles, which in turn will assist in achieving personal and educational goals. It is also an opportunity to introduce students to community agencies that provide health services, information and support. Many of our students return to school after years away from the classroom and therefore require considerable support in their endeavours to succeed in their studies. We also have a high proportion of “newly arrived students” who have only been in Australia for weeks, months or a couple of years.

Last year we had over 60 displays and stalls ranging from sexual health and drug awareness, to healthy eating and road safety. We also had a record number of students attending from metropolitan schools – 8 high schools and Curtin University were represented

Our target group will once again be students and staff from CJ as well as other metro high schools and community members who regularly attend the festival. The students at our campus hail from over 50 different countries giving us a truly multicultural learning environment.

The Year 11 and 12 Health Studies classes are involved in coordinating the day as part of their assessment which includes assisting with set-up and pack-up. The students will be using the Health Festival as a major part of their health promotion strategies. Each student will spend some extended time with their chosen stalls.

- Set up **before** 10 am, pack up at 1:00pm ish (negotiable) Note: it is very busy at 10:15am so be ready!

- Interact with students, teachers and visitors as they walk around the stalls
- Network with other agencies
- Morning tea and lunch will be provided by our Hospitality students
