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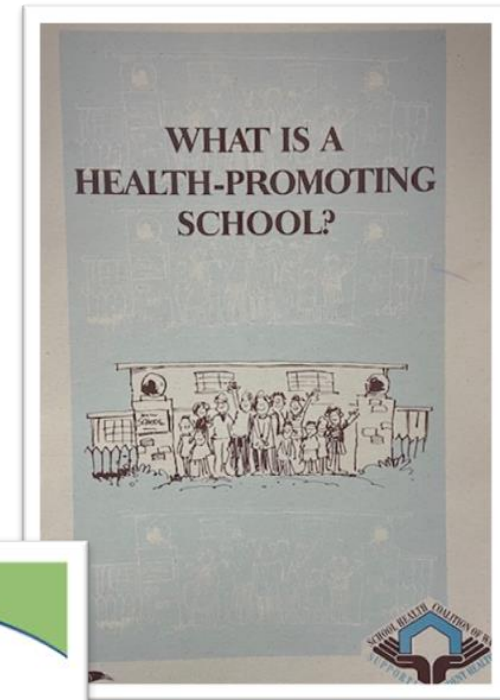
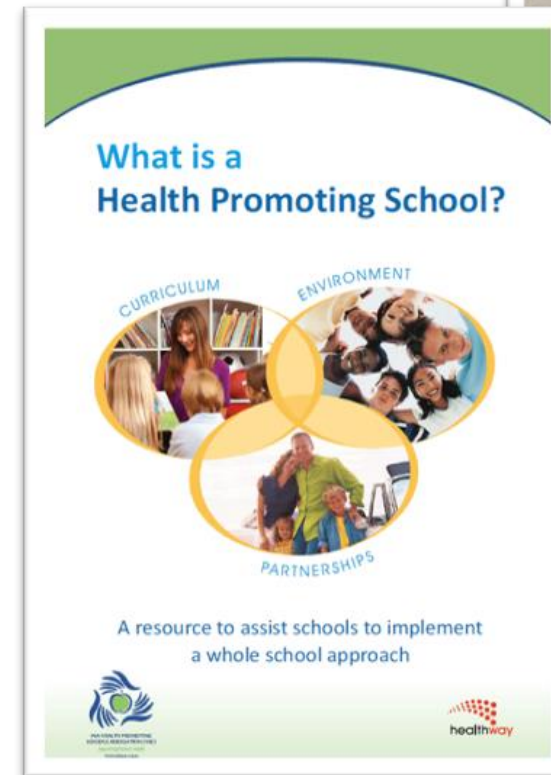

Increase schools' awareness of tools, resources & programs available

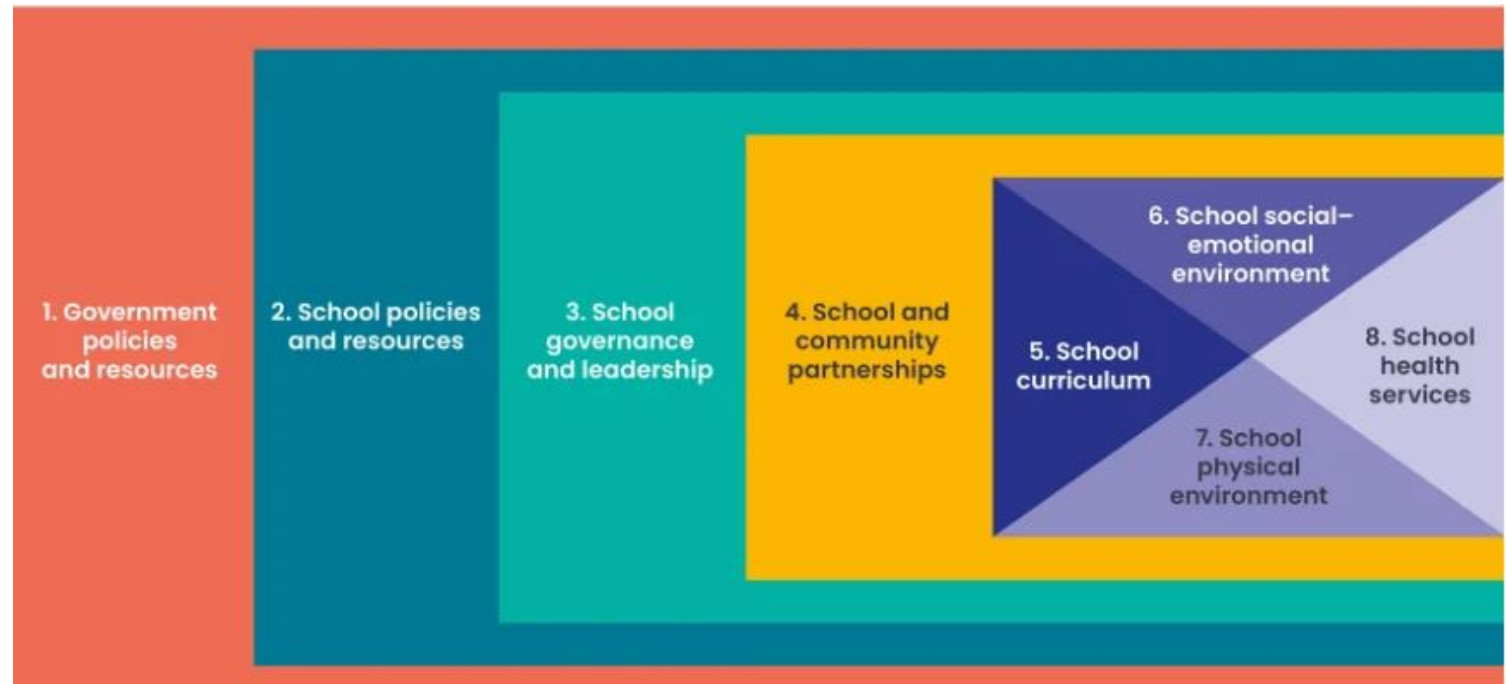


What is a Health Promoting School? resource
